

## Hayward Community Credit Union “CU \$ucceed” Scholarship

**Purpose:** HCCU developed this scholarship to assist “Non-traditional” students in reaching goals for higher education. The term “Non-traditional Student” is defined by any of the following: 1) Delayed enrollment into a higher education program 2) Part-time attendance 3) Working full-time 4) Financially independent from parents 5) Have children or dependents besides spouse 6) Single parent 7) GED holder. Non-traditional students often have needs that differ from those of their traditional counterparts. Many need the convenience of a flexible schedule in which online classes work well for this group. The CU \$ucceed scholarship is aimed to provide assistance to adult students to pursue educational programs that will help gain employment, obtain a better job or lead to a promotion.

**Application Process:** Applications will be accepted from February 1 through May 15 of each calendar year. The scholarship will be awarded on the first business day after May 30<sup>th</sup>. Applications may be picked up at our branch locations or online at [hccuonline.com/Resources/Scholarships](http://hccuonline.com/Resources/Scholarships). The scholarship must be used within the same calendar year as awarded. The funds or check will be made directly to the school in which the student is enrolled. An HCCU scholarship committee (consisting of the Teller Supervisor, Vice President and one member of the Board of Directors) will select the applicant(s) to be awarded each year.

**Funds Awarded:** Each year, one \$750 scholarship will be awarded. In the event of a year in which no qualified applicants were received or the funds were not used, the funds will be rolled into the following year. HCCU then reserves the right to either award 2 deserving candidates \$750 each or grant the full amount to one student. A maximum limit of 3 years totaling \$2250 will continue to build until up to 3 scholarship candidates qualify to receive the funds. The funds awarded are a direct donation from Hayward Community Credit Union. Recipients must be a member of HCCU.

**Award Criteria:** The criteria used for selecting applicant(s) to receive the CU \$ucceed Scholarship will be based on the following:

- Financial needs
- Work history
- Writing skills, demonstrated on your application process
- Goals for future success
- Prior academic achievements
- Community involvement
- HCCU membership
